 Fabulous Fred (IRE) (2004 g. by Beneficial (GB)): placed twice in N.H. Flat Races at 5 years; also **winner** over hurdles at 6 years and placed 3 times and placed 3 times over fences, 2013; also placed once in a point-to-point at 4 years.  
 Doctor Dylan (IRE) (2005 f. by Beneficial (GB)): winner of a point-to-point at 6 years.  
 Ser Sandor (IRE) (2009 g. by Subtle Power (IRE)): placed once in a point-to-point at 6 years, 2015.
